

## Hayward USD High School Graduation Requirements

240 units required as follows:

10 units = one year-long course [6 period days] or one block

English: 40 units

Math: 30 units; Must pass algebra

Science: 20 units

Physical Science: 10

Biological Science: 10

Social Science: 30 units

World History, Culture and Geography: 10

US History: 10

American Government/Economics: 10

Foreign Language, Visual and Performing Arts, or Vocational: 20 units

Physical Education: 20

Electives: 80

Pass the CAHSEE Test

There are three program types for ELLs in High School:

Structured English Immersion (SEI), for all ELLs at CELDT levels 1-3, unless waived into bilingual instruction; Bilingual Alternative Program, and the Mainstream English Language Program (CELDT levels 4-5).

The examples (ELL forms 40-42) illustrate how the SEI and Bilingual Programs serve as preliminary phases prior to transition into the Mainstream English Language Program.
