When students initially enroll in a California school, State and Federal laws require all districts to give a test to those whose home language is not English. The name of this test is the California English Language Development Test (CELDT). Its purpose is to determine how well each student tested can speak, listen, read and write in English.

Your student has been given the CELDT, and the results have identified him/her as an:
